Samuel Haughton born in Carlow, (21 December 1821 – 31 October 1897) was an Irish clergyman, medical doctor, and scientific writer. In 1866, Haughton developed the original equations for hanging as a humane method of execution, whereby the neck was broken at the time of the drop, so that the condemned person did not slowly strangle to death.
